Lutheran Social Service of Minnesota walks with families in a housing crisis to provide crucial support, including housing/rental assistance, mental health services, goal-planning and guidance to help them maintain stability and thrive. Adopt-a-Family

Receive a wish list with items that families have requested – often warm clothing, bedding, pajamas, sweatshirts/sweatpants, games, books, toys, hats, and mittens.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q. Who does Adopt-A-Family serve?

A. This holiday gift program supports families who are in a housing crisis and working with Lutheran Social Service to secure stable housing, achieve job and school goals and strengthen family stability. This holiday season, we are aiming to providing holiday gifts to 125 families we serve.

Q. How does Adopt-A-Family work?

A. You receive a form from Lutheran Social Service that provides a brief description of the family and their holiday wish list. We recommend shopping for 1-2 gifts for each person in the family and spending a maximum of \$40 per person.

Q. When and where should gifts be delivered?

A. You are invited to drop off your gifts from December 11-20 at the LSS Minneapolis Office, 2400 Park Avenue in Minneapolis. Our team will distribute gifts to families.

Q. Should gifts be wrapped?

A. We recommend that gifts come unwrapped with a name attached to each gift, so that parents can wrap gifts for their children. Simply place gifts with a name attached in a large bag with the family's name on the outside of the bag. If you would like to provide wrapping paper, families would greatly appreciate it!

Q. Should I include a gift receipt?

A. Yes! Please include gift receipts in case a family needs to return an item for a different size, color, etc.

Q. Can I send a financial gift?

A. If you would rather not shop but want to support a family, we recommend gift cards to major retailers, such as Target, Wal-Mart, Cub or other retailers with multiple locations.

Q. Can I meet the family I sponsor?

A. The families we support are so appreciative of these gifts! They are in a vulnerable place in their lives, and also appreciate being anonymous.

Q. How do I start the process to Adopt-A-Family for the holidays?
